Dear Mr. Geary,


Many thanks for the report from Pennsylvania. Up until the night of July 23, 1956, when you heard us, we had been conducting nightly equipment tests. We aren't, as yet, on a regular schedual. When we do get on, we will be a 5000 watt, daytime, directional.

Our antenna system consists of two, 154 foot towers, spaced 103 feet and phased 130 degrees. This gives us a pattern to the NW along our tower line $N30^{\circ}W$ true.

The transmitter, a BC 5E, and associated equipment, is made by Gates Radio of Quincy, Ill.

We would like to hear from you if, by chance, we are picked up in Walnutport again.
