In reply to your DX report of October 14, 1946.
It gives me great pleasure to receive your letter and to hear this station came in so well there.

This station conducts a frequency test transmission each Monday morning from 2:15-2:30 AM MST. The equipment here is all Western Electric, we use a 451-A-1 transmitter, 23-C Console, and 1126-B Limiting Amplifier. This is a new station, or at least comparatively new, we began regular operation August 4, 1946 and have had fairly good luck with our operation since then. We are now an ABC affiliate, going on the net about two weeks ago.

In case you arent familiar with this part of the country, I will try to tell you a little about it if you would be interested. The town of Burley is a town of about 6000 population, located midway between Salt Lake City, Utah and Boise Idaho. It is also 100 miles South of Sun Valley. That is about all the information I can think of that might interest you.
