I'm pleased to hear you were able to hear WRRR so well during our frequency check Monday morning, February 13th. I am very happy to verify your reception report stating reception of WRRR on February 13th which is correct. We conduct our frequency check the second Monday morning of each month from 2:30 AM to 3:00 AM, C.S.T.

WRRR operates directional with a power of 1000 watts using two 185 ft. guyed towers. We use a Collins 20V transmitter. This station has only been on the air slightly over two years, but it is "Rockford's Most Listened-To Station".

Thank you for your reception report and hope you will be able to listen to WRRR again soon. Best of luck to you in tuning in many more stations.
