
Dear Mr. Geary,

I am pleased to verify your reception of WLLS-AM, Hartford - Beaver Dam, Kentucky, on Saturday, November 28, 1981 Sign-Off. We do from time to time receive requests from fellow DX'ers like yourself, and are happy to respond. WLLS-AM has been heard as far north as Chicago and in the Southwest as far as San Antonio, Texas. Your recording was excellent and the voice on the Sign-Off is mine. I have enclosed a copy of our WLLS-AM Sign-Off for your records.

For your information, your WLLS-AM transmitter is a General Electric XT-1A, Circa 1948 rated at 1000 watts. However, we run only 506 watts power output. The transmitter uses two 833-A tubes as finals and two 833-A tubes as modulators. It does have excellent quality for a transmitter that age.

Again, we are very pleased to confirm our WLLS-AM signal. Seasons Greetings!
