It was nice to be able to cooperate with the IRCA to schedule this test. Being an avid DX'er myself I can thoroughly understand the joy and resultant anticipation in waiting for QSL confirmation.

In closing, I'll mention that WTMT utilizes a three tower directional array at a power of 500 watts. The towers are designed with an extremely heavy null to the southeast, as to protect a station in that direction. Our antennas are located in Jeffersonville, IN which is just north of Louisville, across the Ohio River.

Kermit, thanks for your letter and thanks for the interest in our station. As I mentioned being an avid DX'er myself I was only happy to conduct this test and to answer all the replies I've had. After all this is the only time using long distance pays off for us and not Ma Bell!
