Thank you for your letter of September 15th; sorry for the delay in replying.

This will verify the fact that it was WALE you heard on Wednesday morning, September 15, 1948, at which time we were carrying our primary election returns.

We are a five-month-old 250-watter, Raytheon-equipped throughout. Our antenna is a 160-foot Wincharger type 300, located atop an 80-foot office building in downtown Fall River. Our operating schedule is 6:00 AM to 1:00 AM, Monday through Saturday; and 8:00 AM to 1:00 AM on Sundays. We are on a test with Riverhead on the first and third Saturdays of each month, from 2:45 AM to 3:00 AM.

Your letter was of particular interest to us, since it's the first one we've received from Pennsylvania. Many thanks for writing.
