Let me thank you very much for your fine detailed letter concerning a listening check on WHEE as of Sunday, January 20, 1952 in the period of 8:00 to 8:26 AM EST.

This is our formal confirmation that the information for identification purposes is entirely correct, and that there is no doubt that you were listening to WHEE (formerly known as WBMS).

This station operates on an assigned frequency of 1090 kc with the power of 1,000 watts; and uses a late model Western Electric transmitter feeding into a 250' uniform cross section antenna located on the banks of the Malden River in Medford (which is about 4 miles due north of Boston).
