Many thanks for your DX letter of the 16th.

WVOB operates on 1520 kilocycles, with 250 Watts, daytime and non-directional. We have been on the air since June 11th.

Your letters, like many others I have received, mentions some interference from WKBN, and they are very strong in here at night. But I have had many DX letters from Pennsylvania and New Jersey who have said they were able to read us all right through KBW's signal.

Almost all of our equipment here in the studio is brand-new, and much of it from Gates. Our transmitter is a slightly used RCA which seems to be doing a much better job for us than I frankly thought it would. - I'd be happy to show you around if you are ever this way.
