WNLF used to be WGWY and prior to that was WCER which came on the air in August of 1956. We have only recently changed our call letters and have used the christian format since 1980.

We have a rather small staff for a 5,000 watt station but are daytime only and directional to the Northeast toward the Lansing market. Our transmitter is made by RCA and our signal area ranges from Jackson to Flint to Mount Pleasant to Grand Rapids and back toward Charlotte again. This places about 600,000 people in our potential audience.

We haven't had a chance to print up new bumper stickers or other promotional material since the call letters have been changed, however, I do have a "Stick-Up" I will send as well as a copy of our listening area. I hope you will enjoy these as much as I have enjoyed your letter.
