However a lot of the fellows did identify them -- Especially the Sousa marches. The first number, if you are interested was "Coronation March" by Meyer-Beyer.

We are using a standard RCA 250G transmitter here but we have a 281 foot vertical radiator and an exceptional ground system. Also our location is particularly advantageous and we believe we have the finest little "100 watter" in the country.

The station is printing some verification cards and, if you like, I can send you one when they come in from the printer.

In the meantime this letter will serve as verification of your reception of KYSM.
