Thank you for your acknowledgement of reception of WKKQ on Monday, April 11, 1977. Your account of our programming is quite accurate. Normally, we are a daytime only station; but because of the fire emergency in our area at the time, we were given special permission from the F.C.C. to continue programming all through the night. We were broadcasting with our full 5000 watts non-directional power.

We have applied to the F.C.C. to change our frequency to 1080 Khz and increase our operating power to 10,000 watts full time. We expect this to be in operation by the end of this year, so look for us then. Best of luck to you, and keep DX'in.
