

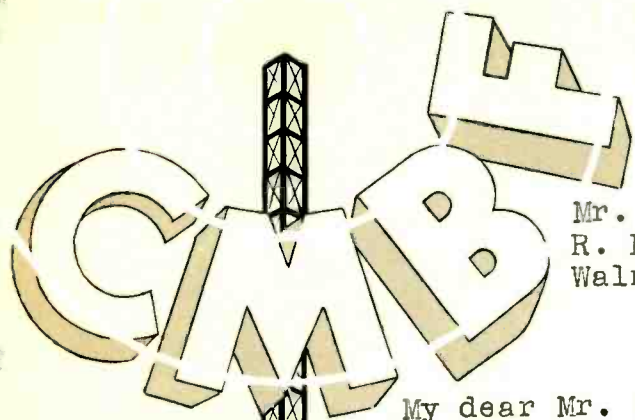

My dear Mr. Geary:

We have received your letter of April 18 and, believe us, it has been a great pleasure for us to learn you enjoyed such a good reception of our long wave station C.M.B.F. 730 Kcs.

Yours is the most complete and accurate report we have from the U. S. A., a few months ago we received another one from a listener in Illinois; but he was not able to send us such a log report like yours.

In this opportunity I take pleasure to inform you that on April 30, with a program entitled "FAITH IN OUR VICTORY" we started our broadcasts through our short wave station C.O.B.F. operating in a frequency of 6040 Kcs. in the 49 meter band. This program was rebroadcast by the Columbia Broadcasting System at 9:45 p.m. E.W.T. Prominent Cuban personalities delivered short speeches, among them were: President Fulgencio Batista; Dr. Aristides Sosa de Quesada, Minister of Defense; Dr. Joaquín Martínez Saenz, Minister of Agriculture and others.

Station C.O.B.F. - 6040 Kcs. 49 M. band - is on the air since only a few days ago, therefore, we have not any report from the U. S. of A. up to this date, and we would like to know if you would be as kind as to tune in our short wave programs at different hours during our broadcast time, from 12 noon to 12:00 p.m., E.W.T., and let us know your
