It is with pleasure we confirm your reception of Radio Station CKCW on the morning of May 10th-1947.

Your report was interesting, in view of the fact that CKCW shares the frequency of 1220 KC with WGAR-Cleveland, resulting in considerable interfearence at much shorter distances than your location.

For your information, CKCW transmits with the power output of 5000 watts, non-directional until sunset, and then directional during the evening hours. The transmitter is an RCA 5 E/F located at Cherryfield, approximately 5 miles from the city of Moncton. New Brunswick.

We thank you for the report and extend best wishes for your centinued good reception.
