Dear Mr. Geary:

You may use this letter to confirm your DX report of WDLV, Pinehurst, North Carolina. Your report of our programming was perfect.

For your information WDLV signed on the air on March 25, 1980. It transmits with a two-tower 1/4 wave directional antenna system with one null bearing  $280^{\circ}$ . The facility is located about two miles south of Pinehurst.

A check of our horizontal plane radiation shows a field in your direction at one mile of approximately 250 milivolts/meter. Our transmitter is a Gates BC-1G. Audio processing includes a Dorrough D.A.P. (Discriminant Audio Processor) and a radio shack equalizer modified to provide a balanced 600 ohm output.

Thank you for your report. I will post it on the station's bulletin board.
