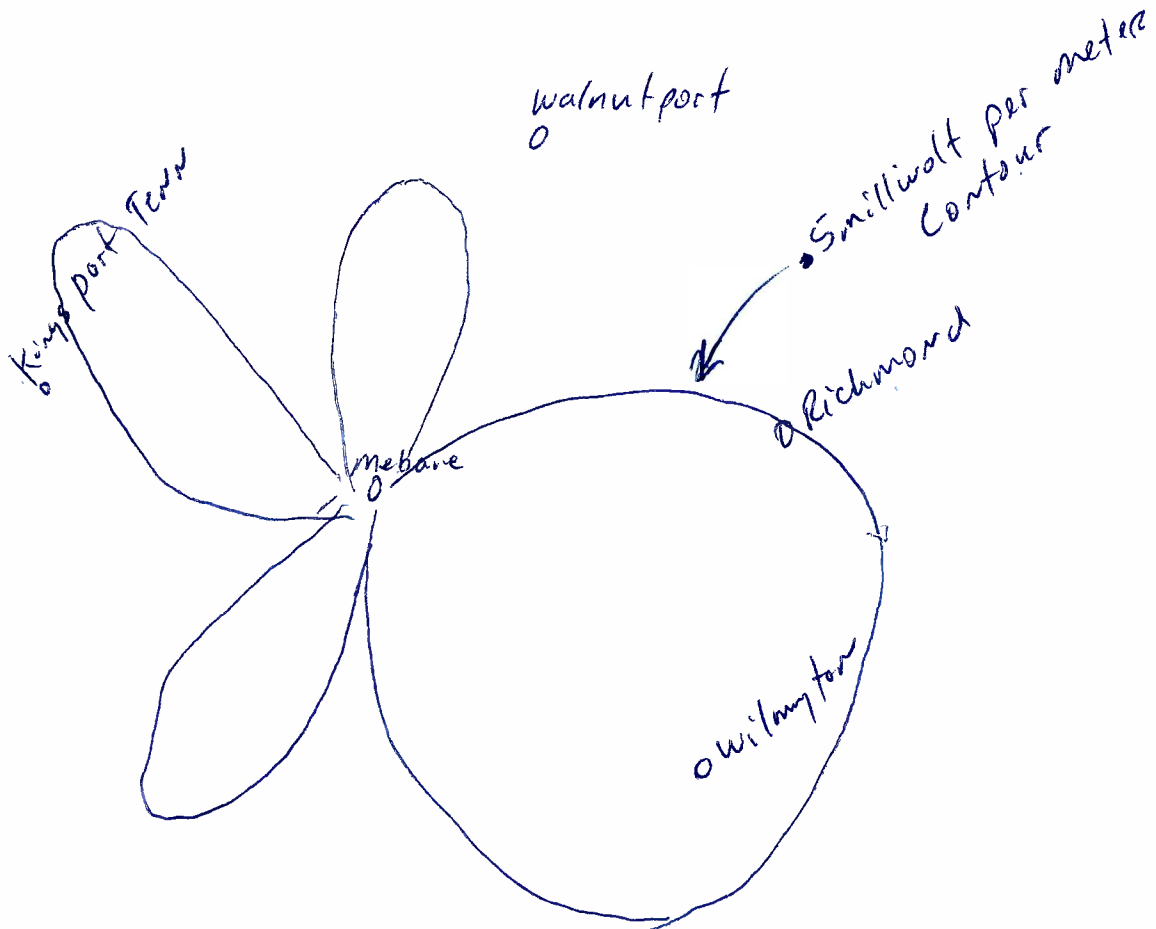


Kermit,

As Chief Engineer of WGLH I was very excited to receive your DX Report. The power output at the time you were listening was 500 watts. Kermit we operate this station under what is called Critical Hours authorization (CH) This means that two hours ~~B~~ After sun up we go to authorized power 1000 watts and two hours Before sunset we reduce to 500 watts on this particular Day we signed on at 6:45 AM with 500 watts till 8:45 increasing to 1000 watts till 3:15 PM Reducing to 500 watts till signoff @ 5:15 PM The station operates as a DA-3 (Directional antenna day and night with changing patterns, and an additional pattern change. We are one of the few stations in the USA that operates DA-3. This is because of the critical protection that KYW requires here in this part of the country. We operate a 3 tone Directional array excited by a 1 Kw CCA Transmitter. The array pattern is sketched for you on the next page - This is the pattern we were using

at the time of your reception report
