I am sorry that someone from WRNS did not get back to you before now to confirm your listening on the evening of 12/26/90. Your report, attached, is correct as to what we were airing at the time you were listening.

WRNS-AM is the old WFTC, with both stations now owned by Pinnacle Broadcasting, as of 6/14/89. We simulcast virtually 100% of the time, breaking away on the AM only for such long-form programming as Kinston Indians Baseball, North Carolina basketball and football, etc.

WRNS-AM operates daytime with 5,000 watts and evenings with 250 watts.
