This will acknowledge your DX letter of January 15, 1982.

I am happy to confirm beyond any possible doubt that you heard WYRU Friday morning, January 15, from 6:53 till 7:06 A.M. We were broadcasting with a power of 1000 watts at that hour, using our RCA BTA-5H transmitter.

We changed our facility from 1000 watts on 1510 kHz to 5000 watts day, 1000 watts critical hours on 1520 in March, 1980. We have another change pending, subject to FCC approval - with luck you may hear us on 1160 one of these days!
