Dear Kermit:

This note is to confirm your reception of WZKY as per your log of September 29, 1987.

Our power during the time of your reception was only about 11.5 watts! Considering the power level, we consider your reception to be rather exceptional. We feel that two factors contributed. First, it does not appear that many stations are taking advantage of the pre-sunrise authority granted to stations such as WZKY that have been broadcasting on Canadian clear channels. Second, we are informed by a number of folks that the period of time during late September and early October in critical hours has been one of unusually good "skip" signals.

A few other facts you might find interesting about us...we have a daytime power of 1000 watts and we broadcast in C-Quam AM stereo. We have been stereo since early 1986 and it has been very successful for us. In fact, we have a hard time understanding why many other AM stations have not already converted to stereo. We have two transmitters and we take pride in maintaining state of the art studios with a strong maintenance program.

Thanks for the report, and if you have the opportunity, come visit with us in Albemarle.
