

This letter is to confirm reception report of WBIO, Parsippany, New Jersey. All transmissions are broadcast with a power of 1 Kw. (One Thousand Watts).

WBIO is a daytime station operation with a four tower direction antenna system north west from Parsippany. Transmitter used is a Gates Vanguard II. Frequency checks are made the fourth Monday night/Tuesday morning of the month at 12:15 AM with a one thousand hertz (1 kc) modulated tone.
