Thank you very much for the report on your reception, of our signal on November 10,1951.

Please forgive me for not answering sooner, but getting a new station on the sir, together with Christmas Holidays and winding up the year's business, I am sure you can image that I was quite busy.

I have checked back over our logs, and am happy to verify your log checks with ours.

Discribing our equiptment, we have a new Gates 250 GY transmitter rated at max. output 250 watts, and is presently delivering only 100 watts output. The antenna is 150' vertical uniform cross section windcharger tower, which ic shunt fed. Ground system of 120 radials 150 ' long in addition to 120 more radials 30 ' long. These radials are not in water, but very close to it.

I have enclosed a folder from our local Bureau of Public Relations which will give you a discription of our city.

If you should ever visit this area, you are most welcome to drop in and see our station.

We are planning a special DX program sometime in the future, and will verify immediately all reports, I promise.

You may pass this information to your fellow DXers. Maybe you would like to advise us at what time would be best for such a program.
