Dear Mr. Geary:

This letter will serve as verification of your very fine report of reception on KTRC Jan. 20th. It is a real pleasure to get a complete report of reception such as you have sent. The reason for the slight pause at 3:15 to 3:17 was to change crystals.

KTRC went on the air Jan. 5th and is an ABC and a Zia Network Outlet. The equipment is RCA all the way except for Presto Recorders. The antenna is a 175 foot self-supporting Lehigh set on a 30 foot steel supporting structure so as to bring the base of the tower and the ground system above the roof of adjoining buildings. The outer ends of the ground wires are tied to No. 4 copper wire suspended between steel poles. The studios and control room were designed by Dr. Boner of the Uni. of Texas and are the latest in sound treatment.
