Please accept this letter as confirmation that you did receive WLVL's New Year's Eve broadcast.

WLVL is tuned at 1340 kHz. We broadcast at 1000 watts daytime and 250 watts night-time. While we normally broadcast only 5 a.m. to 12 midnight, we did broadcast a Christmas and New Year's Eve special that kept us on all night those two nights.

While we don't expect you to become a regular WLVL listener, it's good of you to "tune" us in once in a while. You might be interested in knowing that we also have WBVP in Beaver Falls, Pa. as one of our group stations and are in the process of acquiring WGAL in Lancaster, Pa. Perhaps you can pick up them.
