Dear Mr. Geary:

This is to verify your reception report of March 17th, of our experimental station W8XO. These call letters are used only when we are on the air for test purposes. As you perhaps know we use 700 kilocycles (423.3 Meters) and with the power of 500,000 watts. This is the same frequency that we use for WLW during the regular broadcasting schedule during the day and evening.

The daily schedule of WLW is as follows: on the air in the morning at 6:30 A.M. and then after operating continuously for 19½ hours we sign off at 2:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time.

We thank you for your interest in writing to us, and trust that you will continue to enjoy good reception from our stations WLW - W8XO - WSAI - WBXAL.
