This is a verification of your report to us, regarding the reception of our Standard Broadcast Program and Signal, as heard by you on November 8, 1950.

I am very happy to verify this for you and glad to receive the good report concerning our signal.

Our equipment at the station is RCA throughout. We are radiating 250 watts on AM and also 10,200 watts FM, 101.3 MC. On AM we are using a 285 foot shunt fed tower, with FM antenna on top this tower.

WATG FM/AM maintains a Frequency check schedule every second Friday morning of the month, between 2:00 and 2:30, tone modulation only.
