Dear Mr. Geary,

This confirms your report of reception of Radio Station WIXY of Cleveland, Ohio.

WIXY operates on 1260 Kc. with five thousand watts power. We have a 24 hour operation and are off-the-air only from Sunday at midnight until 6:00 AM Monday morning.

Our studio-transmitter is located eight miles south of Cleveland in Seven Hills, Ohio.

Alternate main transmitters in use are RCA models 5F and BTA 5R1.


A five tower in line antenna array of quarter wave radiators is employed during the night pattern and three towers during the day pattern. The day time array is a triangular configuration with one  $5/8$  wave length radiator.

A test and maintenance period is held during the off-the-air period noted above.

A frequency test is held at 0200 hours the first Monday of each month.
