We broadcast from a Gates-BCIG 1,000 Watt Transmitter and feed two 180 feet towers. The North tower is fed 120 degrees out of phase to give us a directional pattern almost due South. Our Chief Engineer is Charles Lewis.

We are a daylight to dark station. Located in a rural farm area we cater to the farmer with farm programs consisting of grain and livestock reports. In the morning we have the "Dave Walker & Tom Peake Show" which consist of playing special requests, announcing local birthdays and anniversaries, sending personal greetings and get-well wishes, asking questions and giving opinions. This show is well received and popular in the community. In the afternoon we have religious programs and a "Common Market" - a show which permits the public to buy, sell or trade their personal goods. The "Dave Culp Show" is a favorite with the young listeners as Dave plays records and takes special requests. Monte Larrick is our newsman.
