It is with great pleasure that I am able to confirm your reception of WQIO on Sunday, January 10, 1982. Between the times of 5:01 PM EST and 5:15 PM EST. I have checked your log with the program log and they match in all respects.

I am somewhat surprized and very pleased to receive a reception report from so close to KYW. We are very much aware of KYW here as they are the reason we are a daytime instead of a fulltime station.

Our transmitter is a Collins 21E which was installed in 1963 when the station went from one kilowatt non-directional to five kilowatts directional. Our main lobe is in the direction 232° from true North.

As for our construction permit for 1070. This has not been granted yet. WEEP in Pittsburgh, on 1080 has filed to also move to 1070, also for the fulltime operation. Our two applications are mutually exclusive and we are presently fighting it out before the commission. WKOK in Sunbury has also filed against WEEP, contending that WEEP's move to 1070 will cause WKOK undue interference. The prevailing opinion is that WEEP will not get the permit, we have about an 85% chance of ggtting it. But the time frame is two to three years for award of the construction permit.
