I am pleased to indeed, confirm your listening, to Radio Station CFYN, on Friday afternoon, Dec. 4, 1981.

We purchased a new Harris MW 10 A 10 Kilowatt transmitter in mid-July, 1981. Its solid state, and Pulse Duration Modulation capability, has made our station the dominant signal in the marketplace.


We understand, from the Gates-Harris Corporation, that our transmitter, was the first of its type, to be sold in Canada.

At dusk, however, according to CRTC regulations and Dept. of Communications licencing, we cut back to 2500 watts.

We are omni-directional, with single antenna, daytime, and a two tower array, nighttime. We broadcast 24 hours, 7 days per week.
