Thank you for your interest in W G H W.

W G H W operates on a frequency of $1110\ \mathrm{khz}$. with a power of 500 Watts.

Our antenna system consists of a 92 degree, uniform cross sectional, vertical radiator, 227 feet high.

Our transmitter facility employs 2, RCA type BTA-1M transmitters.

W G H W 's studios and transmitter are located at 2311 Old Arch Rd. in Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

W G H W originally signed on the air as W N A R August 16th, 1946.

W G H W serves Philadelphia, Montgomery, Chester, Deleware, Bucks, and Berks Counties of Pennsylvania, as well as surrounding Counties of New Jersey, Deleware, and Maryland.

W G H W is a key station for the Montgomery County Emergency Communications network, and The Emergency Broadcast System.

W G H W's programming is gospel and Christian oriented.
