Thank you for your reception report on October 1, regarding WHEX Radio.

WHEX is indeed, a new AM station, having signed on last May. To date, we have received, among others, reception reports from Pittsburgh, Long Island, N.Y. and Cape Cod, Mass. I will add your name to the growing list. We are using a Harris model MW-1A, 1000 watt transmitter, stepped down to 500 watts at 1580 kHz. Our tower is 100 feet tall, located with our transmitter and studio/offices, atop what is probably the highest point in Lancaster County. That, coupled with an excellent ground system and the new transmitter, and we are sending out a clean, clear signal.

I have attached some information so you will have a better idea of WHEX. Also, I passed your letter to our chief engineer and he was delighted to receive it.
