Thank you so much for your full and interesting report of reception of WJET, between 5:35 and 5:45PM, on Feb. 23, 1952 Your complete comments prove definately that you were tuned to WJET.

I am rather surprised that you would receive us, especially at this date. Actual sunset for Feb. 23 was after six, which of course places your reception quite a few minutes before the effects of "Skywave" should be apparent.

During December we were received near Detroit at approximately sunset. The radiating system here is a 185' tower on top a 20' building. The tower is grounded and is shunt fed by a slant wire feed.

This will also confirm your reception of our first equipment test Sept. 30, 1951.
