This will confirm your reception of WPCN as described in your very specific letter of March 18th, 1981/


At the times indicated(March 17 and 18)we were in the process of making field strength readings in the nondirectional mode. At approximately 4pm on the 18th, we switched back to our normal directional mode, which accounts for your failure to read us at 4:30pm (we were on until 6pm).

WPCN operates at 1,000 watts with a 4-tower directional antenna array. Approximate coverage is shown on the other side. We officially went on the air Wednesday, April 8th, 1981. Normally you will probably not be able to receive us very well at your location due to the directional pattern we use.

I apologize for the delay in this confirmation, but with all the problems associated with getting a new facility on the air, I have not had a chance prior to this. We thank you for your interest in WPCN Pocono 96.
