This letter is to verify your reception of WGNG on 1-8-73 · WGNG's studios and transmitting facilities are located in Cumberland, Rhode Island. We operate on a frequency of SSOKH2 with a power output of 1800 watts non-directional during the day and 500 watts directional during the night.

WGNG operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Our transmitting facilities consist of two RCA BTA-IR

I KW transmitters. We have two series fed guyed towers

standing 303 Feet tall and are separated by a distance of

298 feet. WGNG's daytime signal covers all of Rhode Island

most of eastern and central Massachusetts, and parts of

Connecticut. At night we cover Rhode Island and southeastern

Massachusetts despite our low power.

We appreciate your reception report, and would like to thank you for taking the time to write us.

Thank you very much for your participation in our special test. Conditions to the south of us did improve later in the morning.
