Dear Kermit,

Survey-proven #1 Radio Musical is pleased to verify your report of reception of our special broadcast on January 18, 1964. All details included in your letter check exactly with the station log.

Your reception of HCRM1 in such fine conditions has been an encouragement to all of us who work at Radio Musical.

At the time of your reception, we were operating with a reduced power of 8 800 watts, fed into a 175 foot vertical top loaded tower.

Local weather at the time of reception was: dense fog with a temperature of 12.5 degrees.

HCRM1 transmitters are located on a hill several kilometers to the north of downtown Quito, with studios located 40 blocks away.

Radio Musical normally operates on 570 kilocycles, but for the special program, a frequency of 565.5 was used.

HCRM1 has been rated #1 in Quito, with an audience share of 55%, the remaining45% divided among the 32 other stations here.
