Thank-you so much for your signal report of WGVL. It was quite a surprise to discover that we were getting into Pennsylvania!

We are located in the Northwest corner of South Carolina. We are about 150 miles ENE of Atlanta, Georgia, and about a hundred miles east of Charlotte, N.C..

We operate on an assigned frequency of 1440 kilohertz AM, with a directional pattern at night. We run 5000 watts both day and night. At night, we have a 4 tower directional array beaming our signal in a south easterly direction.

Once again, Thanks for the fine signal report.
