We are operating from a 163 foot antenna one mile NE of Bolivar with a RCA BTA-250M xmtr (modified) and the newest RCA equipment. Our Broadcast House is also new and all in all a very sweet set-up.

Bolivar is located 60 miles east of Memphis and has a population of 5,000 with a trade area of nearly 60,000. This area is rich in "Old South" traditions and Civil War history and is truly an interesting place to visit.
