
The information you gave indicates that you did receive our station, and I am pleased to confirm your report.

WMAK operates at present on 1300 Kilocycles, with a full time power of 5000 watts, using a full-time directional antenna array of five in-line towers. The towers are oriented at 120° true, and our major lobe extends south-southeast of Nashville, Tennessee.

We have been in operation since July 1, 1948. Our normal operating schedule is from 6:00 AM thru 12:00 midnight, local time.

We have had many fine reports such as yours, and we appreciate each and every one of them very much.
