The information you gave indicates that you did receive our station, and I am pleased to confirm your report.

WMAK operates at present on 1300 Kilocycles, with a full time power of 5000 watts, using a full-time directional antenna array of five in-line towers. The towers are oriented at 1200 true, and our major lobe extends southsoutheast of Nashville, Tennessec.

We have been in operation since July 1, 1948. Our normal operating schedule is from 6:00 AM thru 12:00 midnight, local time.

We have had many fine reports such as yours, and we appreciate each and every one of them very much.
