Thanks very much for your most complete report of reception of our signal on February 21, 1960. We seem to have been getting out pretty well this winter, have had reports from as far away as Australia, New Zealand and Sweeden.

Our antenna is directional and radiates only about 1000 watts in your direction. Didn't think we would have much chance to get through the interference in your area.
