Thank you for your letter reporting reception of WABS on () CER 9/ at 000/-00/3 . Your report agrees with our station log and you may consider this letter an verification of your reception.

WABS features religious programming with a mixture of syndicated and local programs, and contemporary music.

Our station began operating on November 7, 1946, with a power of 1,000 watts and the call letters WARL. The call letters were changed to WAVA in January, 1961, and to WABS in November 1977. Power was increased to 5,000 watts in 1985. Our transmitter is located at the corner of Lee Highway (U.S. Route 29) and George Mason Drive in Arlington. Our studios are also on Lee Highway, about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west of the transmitter. Our antenna system is a unique two tower non-directional array. Also unique is that WABS is one of only 3 radio stations in the United States licensed to a county.

Enclosed is a copy of our program guide. Please enjoy our programs whenever you can.
