I am pleased to confirm your reception report on WNIS dated November 29-30, 1979. You might be interested to know that on the fringes of our listening area, we often get complaints of interference from WSLR in Akron.

A little bit about our station--we operate at five-thousand watts, with a CCA Electronics AM5000DS transmitter as our main; and an RCA BTA5U as an auxilliary transmitter. We have a three-tower directional antenna array, with seperate patterns for day and night operation.

I'm enclosing a rate card from our advertising department that includes a small coverage map and program schedule.
