Dear Mr. Geary,

It was a pleasure to receive your report of reception of our signal on December 15 and 19, 1989. WSTK, Starlight 1290 is a non-directional station, broadcasting with pre-sunrise authority of 500 watts, daytime authority of 5000 watts, and post-sunset authority of 41 watts. Our transmitter is located in Colonial Heights, Va., just north of Petersburg. We are fortunate to have a Harris SX-5 solid state transmitter. Our single tower has an HAAT of 450 feet. Our STL is a brand new Marti model STL-10, so no quality is lost between the studio and transmitter. The only processing we are using currently is an Optimod 8000A in conjunction with an Audimax 4450A limiter.
