You caught me. This is to confirm your reception of WWVT on January 16, 2002 between 17:59 and 1808 hours. I sit here red faced as our transmitter computer system failed to change power at 1730 hours that day when it was supposed to. So we were still on daytime power when we were not supposed to.

Thank you for your report. I don't see as many report as the days when AM was on top of its game. It is good to see there are folks still out there chasing AM DX.

WWVT is owned and operated by Virginia Tech. It is 2800 Watts daytime with 500 Watts PSRA and 45 Watts PSSA. We use a Continental 315R transmitter, CRL shortwave type processing and a series fed 195 foot radiator.
