Greetings!

I am pleased to report that your reception of our radio station, WMYM - AM, Minocqua Wisconsin, shows an accurate sampling of our programming during the scheduled DX test on Sunday, February 10th, 1991.

Our broadcast included series of Morse code signals identifying our station call sign, with periodic voice ID's. This programming was broadcast from 5:30:00 am CST until 5:40:00 am CST. I personally originated the test from our studios.

Please accept this letter as confirmation of your DX reception. Thank you for tuning in, and your interest in our radio station!

WMYM - AM broadcasts at a frequency of 1570 Khz, with a power of 5000 watts, radiated by a single 183' tower. Our transmitter is a CSI T-5-A installed in 1982. We use no audio processing except an NRSC type limiter. Our program format features nostalgic music of the 40's thru the 60's, with adult music of the 70's and 80's. We also feature extensive local news coverage. WMYM began broadcasting as WFBZ AM in the late seventies.
