Dear Kermit,

I am pleased to verify your reception of WVVW on Nov. 17, 1985 from 5:07 to 5:13pm EST.

WVVW studios are located at Greens Run Road, St. Marys, WV. along with WRRR-FM (W3R) which operates on 101.7 mHz with 3 kw ERP. W3R's format is adult contemporary.

The WVVW transmitter (Harris MW1 solid state) is located in Newport, Ohio approximately 2 miles from the studio. The antenna is a 150 ft. vertical, base insulated tower.

We currently have an application on file with the FCC to move to 630 kHz with 500 watts. Hopefully this will happen sometime next spring.

I would be interested in doing a DX test sometime this winter. You might pass this along to the other NRC members. Call me at 304-684-3400 or write a letter with some preferred dates and times.

I haven't done much DXing after midnight the past few years and am not sure which nights are best on 1570 as far as interference is concerned.
