Dear Sir;

It was with great pleasure that I read your letter dated 6/26/67. This verifies your reception from 10.36 to 11.01 AM.

WCKW operates from 6 AM until 10 PM Monday thru Saturday. On Sunday the hours are from 8 AM until 6 PM. We started operations at 9 AM January 10, 1966.

WCKW operates on 92.3 MHz with an power of 56 KW ERP. Our antenna is mounted on the side of a 329' Utility type 480 tower. The antenna is a Collins 37-M-12. A 12 Bay Horiz Radiation, we do not have vertical radiation.

The WCKW transmitter is a Collins 830E-1A a 5 KW unit with the Collins Stereo Generator. Our plans are to modify the 830E to an 830F-1A which is a 10 KW unit which would give WCKW its maximum power authorized 100,000 Watts.

The WCKW studios and transmitters are located about 9 miles west of LaPlace Louisiana on US 61.

If you ever get the chance to visit Louisiana please stop by for a cup of coffee and I will show you the operation.
