Dear Mr. Geary:

This letter is in response to and confirmation of your listener report of 21 July 1975.

Your description of the programming you received matched our logs to a "T".

Your assumption concerning our power and frequency is also correct on 3 November 1974. We began broadcasting on 91.7 MHz with a power of 25Kw Horizontal and 25Kw Vertical Power. We are transmitting with a 10Kw Collins 830F-2A transmitter and Collins 37CP-5 antenna, with a radiation center of 1210.2' above mean sea level.

I have enclosed a copy of the August Program Guide and my card to add to or to start a collection of mementoes of your hobby.

Thank you for your letter and continued good listening.
