Dear Mr. Geary:

Your report of the signal reception of Station KFRX on June 1, 1998 has been forwarded to me. Thanks for the information. As you might have expected, the general area had been experiencing severe thunderstorm activity at the time of your report, so it is possible that weather phenomena may partly explain the peculiar transmission (and listening) conditions.

The information you stated in your letter has been compared to the station program log for the associated period and found to be in substantial agreement.

KFRX operates with an effective radiated power of 100kW. The antenna is a 12 element located at the top of a 500 foot tower, and is excited with 18 kW transmitter output power.

Thank you again for your report. Good listening.
