Dear Kermit:

Thanks for your reception report. This confirms that you did, in fact, receive W285DB, 104.9 MHz, Allentown-Bethlehem, PA on January 28, 1991 from 0655 to 0800 EST. This translator station is licensed to Temple University and rebroadcasts WRTI(FM). It is co-located with WFMZ-TV/FM on East Rock Road, several miles south of Allentown and operates with an effective radiated power of 5 watts.

I'm glad to know that we're sending a useable signal as far away as Walnutport. We've been a bit disappointed with the coverage of the Allentown translator compared with our other translator in Reading, which works very nicely. We plan to increase power in Allentown in several months.

Another new station of ours you may want to listen for late this spring is WRTY, 91.1 Mhz, which will broadcast from atop Camelback Mountain in Jackson Township, Monroe County. It will also rebroadcast WRTI and the Temple Public Radio Network and should cover all of the Poconos and the northern Lehigh Valley. I hope to have it built by July, so when you hear it send me another report.

Enclosed is a coverage map for your files. Thanks again and keep listening!
