Thank you for your very complete report on reception of our station WCAU-FM. We are pleased to confirm the program information which identifies our station.

Our FM antenna is mounted on our television tower at the Roxborough transmitting station and is 620 feet above ground. Our radiated power is 11 KW which corresponds, under the FCC rules, to an effective radiated power of 20 KW with an antenna 500 feet above average terrain.

WCAU-FM operates independently from 1:00 AM to 5:00 AM on Mondays because WCAU is shut down for maintenance and the WCAU programs are therefore not available.
